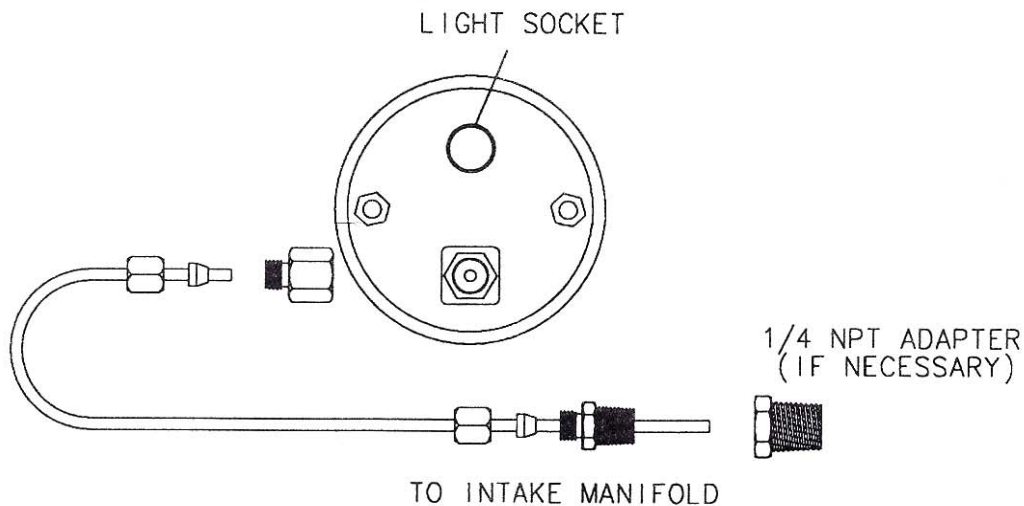


29804 VACUUM GAUGE 30 in Hg

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

MOUNTING

To mount the gauge in an instrument panel, first drill a 2-9/16" hole in the panel, then insert the gauge into the hole and secure with the included mounting hardware.



VACUUM PLUMBING

To plumb the vacuum gauge to a source of vacuum, route the 1/8" tubing from the vacuum gauge to the intake manifold as shown. Most intake manifolds have either a 1/8" or 1/4" NPT tapped hole. Remove the plug and install the pipe fitting(s), then attach the tubing from the vacuum gauge.

For connecting to existing vacuum lines, cut the selected vacuum line and insert the tee fitting provided. Then attach the tube from the vacuum gauge. Do not cut into distributor line or other ported vacuum sources.

LIGHTING

To install lighting in the gauge, insert bulb and socket into the lighting hole in the back of the gauge and connect the red wire to the vehicle's existing lighting circuit.

NOTE: If the gauge is placed in a plastic or wooden instrument panel, connect the black wire to ground.
